This is the month we dedicate to praying for the souls who have left us. As we do this, each one of us is reminded of our own death, and how we can better prepare our souls for it. Avoidance isn't the way to Heaven, imitating Christ in love is. St. Catharine of Genoa offers a meditation worth your time:

O Lord, you brought down from heaven the delightful manna and sweet good of charity which contains in itself such strength that it makes us able to bear any torment; we have seen this by experience first in you, our gentle Master, Lord and guide, and then in your saints.

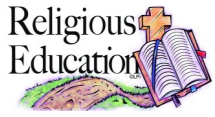
